



Man Tracker Invitational 2018

Property and Event Rules

It is very important that the Man Tracker Invitational be a fun, enjoyable and safe event for all participants and their families or guests as well as for the general public. In order to ensure that this will be the case, the following rules will be enforced;

- Dogs are allowed – must be on leash and any misbehaved dogs will be asked to vacate the premises
- No Recreational Drugs
- Smoking is allowed in the designated smoking area, and all cigarettes must be put out in a safe and controlled manner (Cigarette waste containers will be available)
- It is recommended that all Horses be up to date on vaccinations appropriate to this area (Candle Creek Veterinary Services can assist with what vaccinations that may include) as well as up to date on worming and hoof care. Our local Ferrier will be available on call should a horse need a shoe replaced etc.
- All Participants must sign a waiver releasing the WGRA of all liabilities at the time of Registration (2 pm Friday August 17 at the Wells Gray Golf Course)
- Participants are asked to be ready for their game at least 15 minutes prior to their start time. Prey will be lead to their start line by a WGRA Patrol Volunteer.
- Water is available for horses however everyone is responsible for their own bucket and watering of their horse.
- Corrals are available at the campground for a fee of \$10/night/horse. Everyone is responsible for their own horse manure removal and a designated spot for disposal will be available. Corrals must be left clean and litter free.
- No alcohol is permitted outside of the campground and must be kept in a cup or mug and not a bottle or can.
- Please be Bear Aware and keep all your food and toiletries in a locked camper or horse trailer, or arrangements can be made with the WGRA Volunteers.
- Riding helmets are recommended.
